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“Servant of Sri Venkateshwara”

Direction: Lord Tirumala Sri Venkateswara decided to arrange his “HARINAAMA KSHETRA” near our “Garden well” in my native village Chinna Gundavelli, 7 km. away from Sidhipet. He directed me to construct at least the replica of Tirumala Temple upto two compound walls (Silver Doors). He assured me that He will stay here permanently forever in this area by himself and bless the devotees. Also He suggested to arrange Akhanda Harinam Smaran (chanting constantly) by various devotees in shift system with no break. He also informed me to get blessed by Bhagavataas (great devotees) in order to get eligibility to invite Lord from Tirumala besides rigorous practice (Sadhana).

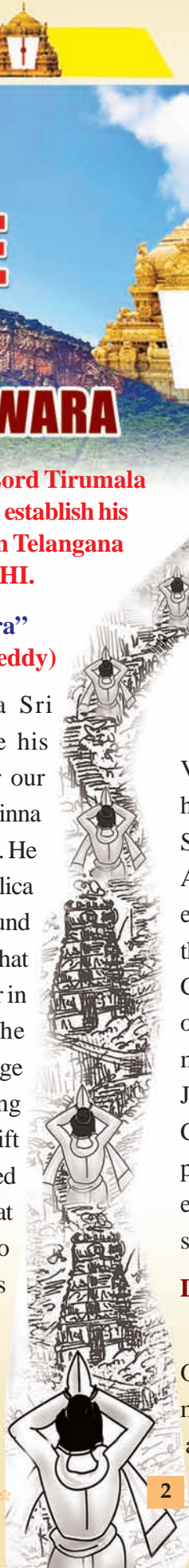
Starting the training from April 2000, thro’ my dreams, He disclosed the actual matter in April 2022. In

addition to this, He ordered me to get the divine feelings published which were blessed by him in order to make the devotees as partners in this programme from April 2023. The publishing of present part-36 is its part only **January 2022 to March 2022).**

Under the guidance of Tirumala Sri Venkateswara, the divine acts shown to me by the Lord have been published in the monthly magazine Sri Venkatesam for the past 36 months, beginning from April 2023. For me, each part has been an extraordinary episode. The same intense joy that I experienced when the Lord first granted these. Recently, the third wave of COVID had set in. People became afraid even to face one another. Although a few Kalyanams (ceremonial marriages of divinities) were scheduled in the month of January, we did not conduct them due to fear of COVID. We also decided to give this Kalyanam program a short break. We prayed to the Lord and explained our helplessness. In response, the Lord showed a small divine act.

Dream of 08-01-2022

We had gone to a place to conduct a Kalyanam. On the stage, some items were being arranged. At that moment, Brahmins arrived. I was speaking to them about something. That was the dream. I could not fully



understand its meaning. Perhaps I was informing them that we were going to give some rest to the program, or perhaps I was seeking their permission for a break.

The Lord's Kalyanams - My Experience

15-01-2022:

So far, out of the total 111 Kalyanams, we have been able to conduct 17 Kalyanams by the grace of the Lord. Now, due to COVID, we have received a period of rest. Once the government permits spiritual programs again, we plan to resume. During this break, I reflected upon my experiences and mental state regarding these Kalyanams, and wrote them down as follows: Earlier, the "Namo Venkatesaya" Rathayatra used to be conducted every year for about 25 days, including the start and end days. From the beginning of the Rathayatra, my mental state and behaviour would be entirely different compared to normal days. Those who observed me closely - especially family members and those who accompanied me - clearly noticed this.

There would be - a kind of thrill in my body, intense mental excitement and an inability to tolerate even the slightest lapse in the Lord's service. If the Rathayatra was delayed for any reason, I could not bear it. There was always a strong longing to reach the devotees quickly. With the desire that as many devotees as possible should have darshan during the Rathayatra, it felt as though Lord Venkateswara Himself filled my entire being. During that time, I would completely forget the sense of "mine".

From 2004 to 2019, for a total of 16 years, we conducted this Rathayatra from Hyderabad to Tirupati. After that, from 2020 onwards, we discontinued it. Now, this chariot was being used in the program called "Sri Srinivasa Kalyanams." In this chariot, along with the Kalyanam materials, we would also take the Lord. We used to reach the venue about 2 hours before each

Kalyanam. Out of this, about 30 minutes were dedicated to ceremonially receiving the Lord.

From a certain distance, the chariot procession used to be welcomed with musical instruments, dances and devotional singing (bhajans), and taken to the Kalyanam venue in a grand manner. This always brought me immense joy. However, the kind of mental transformation I used to undergo during the Rathayatra, I now experience that same kind of spiritual joy during every Kalyanam. This begins in me right from the time the chariot is started from our house. In fact, up to one hour prior the start, these feelings begin to arise within me - such as - a thrill coursing through my body, an overwhelming feeling of joy, and an inability to tolerate even small mistakes or delays.

When the chariot starts from our house, we decorate it with garlands, perform ? rati (a short ritual prayer using a lighted lamp), and break a coconut to begin the procession. At that moment, I experience as though Lord Venkateswara of Tirumala, in His cosmic form, is standing upon the chariot with both His feet placed on it. I behold the Lord to my heart's content and feel immense joy. I have been having this divine experience since 2004, before every Rathayatra journey to Tirupati - and now, it continues in the same way during these Kalyanams as well. On the day of the Kalyanam, I feel as though I am moving in an entirely different world. I experience profound joy. Even after coming home after completing the kalyanam, I continue to experience the same mental state that I used to experience after the conclusion of the 25-day Rathayatra. There is a clear difference between this state and my normal state on other days. This elevated state is especially helpful in understanding the Lord's divine acts. I can clearly perceive the difference between myself in that state and an ordinary person. I feel delighted, thinking that Sri Venkateswara is continuing



these divine acts through me to uplift His devotees. After about two days, I return to a normal state.

Earlier, we used to conduct the Rathayatra for 25 days every year. Now, I feel that by conducting more than 20 Kalyanams annually, we are perhaps making up for those earlier days. I do not know the full extent of the Lord's grace, but one or two days before each Kalyanam, a new energy enters me and fills me with joy. Especially on the eve of the Kalyanam, my eagerness increases greatly. I speak repeatedly with the organizers to ensure that no mistakes occur. I guide them in the right direction and instruct them to consult me on every small matter. I make every effort from my side to ensure that nothing goes wrong.

Since the Kalyanam of Tirumala Sri Venkateswara must be conducted in accordance with the scriptures, we have adopted the Vaikhanasa tradition. We had arranged for all the required vessels to be in brass (as tradition prescribes). If there are any shortcomings from the organizers, we compensate for them and ensure that the Kalyanam is conducted properly according to scriptural injunctions. In a way, we are striving to conduct it in a manner that creates the feeling as though the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) itself is organizing it. We pray to the Lord to grant us the strength and capability required for this effort. I believed that once all the 111 Srinivasa Kalyanams got completed, my resolve would be fulfilled. However, the Lord has not explicitly mentioned that my resolve would be considered fulfilled after these 111 Kalyanams.

Yet, I believe that He knows the desire in my heart and will surely make me happy. Earlier, during the first japasarpana, He fulfilled my wish of seeing His feet even before I asked for it. In the same way, I have faith that He will fulfil this as well. In my previous resolve, I did not act according to His guidance many times. Some mistakes occurred, and as a result, I failed. But

in this resolve, I am living with intense determination to carry it out without any mistakes and earn the Lord's grace. The Lord was also supporting me in this.

Over the past six months (since the start of the Kalyanams on 20-07-2021), I have completely lost interest in - worldly matters, casual interactions and anything unrelated to the Lord. Now, I feel as though I am living entirely in a new world. My life revolves only around - home, office, and service to the Lord. In these six months, I have been living with the same mindset and thoughts that I used to have during the Rathayatra days. My entire focus is on - attaining spiritual eligibility and attaining the Lord. I feel that ultimately, His grace alone is my destiny.

I prayed to the Lord saying, "In this Kali Yuga, an ordinary human being can attain the Lord through constant remembrance of the name of Sri Venkateswara and by serving His devotees. Please let this truth be revealed to the world through me." Just as in the past, through Bhima, even clay flowers were given value equal to golden flowers, I prayed that now the Lord should use me to deliver a new message to the world.

Stating That I Received 700 Experiences

On 15-01-2022, I told Dr. K. V. Ramanaachari for the first time that I had received 700 spiritual experiences. He suggested that I should compile them into a book form as soon as possible, and release it at Tirupati, at the feet of the Lord. I too had the desire to write down these experiences quickly. Therefore, I prayed for an opportunity to publish them. However, since there was no response from the Lord, I remained silent. In fact, at the beginning of the Kalyanam program, I had resolved to seek permission for publication only after completing one-third of the Kalyanams. But forgetting that, I asked for permission midway - this itself was my mistake.

"Keep your mind only on your duty - fulfil the resolve you made"

16-01-2022:

Just before the start of the Kalyanam program, the Lord conveyed the following message through an inner feeling. I had forgotten to write it then, and now I record it as follows:

"You should not engage in even the smallest business. Your mind must remain completely focused on the service of the Lord. Every day, every moment, you must live with that alone as your focus. Do not allow your mind to wander toward any other matters, and under no circumstances should you develop interest in anything else." Thus spoke my Lord, Tirumala Sri Venkateswara. Since I am His servant, I immediately agreed. I am also practicing this as much as possible.

The traditional mark of Sri Venkateswara Mahamantra Peetham

I reflected upon past events as follows: In my first resolve, I failed in offering 111 crore japa to the Lord over 16 years. Because of that, I failed to attain my long-cherished goal of realizing Sri Venkateswara. I felt deeply distressed. However, since I myself had failed, I did not blame the Lord. Instead, I humbly prayed for another opportunity. I considered this new opportunity to be the program of 111 Srinivasa Kalyanams. Now, as far as these 111 Kalyanams are considered, I strive intensely to conduct them in such a way that both the Lord and His devotees are pleased. I double-check everything to ensure that not even the smallest mistake occurs.

I guide - the Lord's servants who accompany the chariot, and the learned Brahmins who conduct the Kalyanam, so that everything is done in a manner pleasing to both the Lord and the devotees. Over the past six months, our team of Lord's servants has come

on to a right path for the service of the Lord. However, the Vaikhanasa Brahmins are relatively new and keep changing for each Kalyanam. Therefore, within a short time, I am trying to identify one or two stable teams and establish a distinct identity of the Sri Venkateswara maha mantrapeetham.

Waiting for the Service of the Lord

Date: 19-01-2021: I am finding it difficult to remain without any activity related to the Lord's service even for 5-6 consecutive days. Every particle in my body is longing intensely for the Lord's service. There is a surge of emotion within me. My mind is restless, yearning to obtain or create an opportunity for service to the Lord. To fulfill this desire, I began reaching out to devotees I knew, encouraging them to conduct Srinivasa Kalyanam. I would tell them: "Receive the grace of the Lord. The expense is not very high. This will remain an unforgettable day in your life." I would also say that through them, their relatives and everyone who witnesses the Kalyanam would receive the Lord's blessings, and that they were fortunate to serve as intermediaries in this divine act.

In the past, there was a demon named Banasura. His daughter Usha was married by Lord Krishna to his grandson Aniruddha. Due to a boon from Lord Shiva, Banasura gained immense strength and became a great warrior. Since he had no worthy opponents, he was always eager for battle, constantly searching for someone to fight.

In a similar way, I too feel an intense longing - but mine is for the service of the Lord. I wait eagerly, as if with a thousand eyes, wondering where and when an opportunity will arise. Recently, due to COVID, the state government banned spiritual gatherings, which caused me great distress. I am waiting for the moment when we can restart. Service to Lord Venkateswara never brings complete satisfaction - it only creates a



desire for more. My mind keeps yearning for greater service. To calm this longing, I keep exploring new ways to serve better. I constantly think about how to perform The Lord's service more effectively. I ensure that mistakes are not repeated and even ask the organizers about any shortcomings. However, they always respond that everything was perfect and that they were completely satisfied. This reassures me that I am on the right path.

Key Aspects of Srinivasa Kalyanams

Those who have conducted Srinivasa Kalyanams through us experience immense joy. I have seen tears of happiness in the eyes of some devotees. Such is the bliss that the Lord bestows upon His devotees. Two days before every Kalyanam, I repeatedly pray to the Lord saying

"Let the Kalyanam be conducted successfully. Shower Your grace upon all those who conduct it and those who witness it." In accordance with these prayers, the Lord blesses all participants and attendees with great love. They become absorbed in divine bliss.

Just as the Tirumala laddu has a unique taste that cannot be replicated if it is made elsewhere - even if made with the same ingredients - similarly, even if the same priests conduct Kalyanams in other places, without our presence, the same level of divine joy is not experienced. I have clearly observed this. For such divine grace bestowed upon us, I feel that we are forever indebted to The Lord.

"May you obtain the gracious blessings of Sri Venkateswara" - The Lord's Blessing

I began to feel distressed because, for the past six months, Lord Venkateswara had not granted me any spiritual experiences. From the day I started the Srinivasa Kalyanams on 20-07-2021, I had almost become distant from His divine acts. Even so, I continued

performing my duty as His servant and carried on with the Kalyanams.

I reflected thus - "in the past, I had not carried out the tasks entrusted to me efficiently. As a result, to put me on the right path, You guided me through many dreams and impressions, embedding them in my heart. Perhaps because of that, I had the fortune of witnessing many of Your divine acts. But at that time, I did not understand why You were showing them. I thought they were merely for my happiness. In any case, I had not followed Your commands. Therefore, You repeatedly revealed Your acts and gradually guided me onto the path You desired. But ever since I began this 'Srinivasa Kalyanams' program, I have been following Your command with utmost sincerity. I have fixed Your goal firmly and given up interest in worldly matters. I have resolved to live only to please You. I felt that perhaps because I was now moving correctly toward Your goal without making mistakes, You were no longer granting me such experiences." Though this pause caused some pain - since I longed to witness His divine acts - I also felt happy, believing that The Lord was pleased because I was obeying His command without error.

On 28-01-2022, a new desire arose in my mind. That evening, I prayed as follows: "Lord Sri Venkateswara! Please accept my salutations and listen to my prayer. Since the year 2000, You have granted me various spiritual experiences. Some made me blessed, and through some, You granted me the fortune of serving You. At every step, You protected me from making mistakes in Your service. You made me construct the Sri Venkateswara Divine Maha mantra Stupa and establish the Sri Venkateswara Maha mantra Peetham. Through it, You have been enabling the offering of 7 crore written chants every year. You had the 'Namo Venkatesaya' chariot built and the Rathayatra conducted. You are running the monthly

magazine 'Sri Venkatesam'. You are continuing the 'Bhaja Govindam' program. Finally, You led me to undertake the 'Srinivasa Kalyanams' program."

"O Lord! Except in this 'Srinivasa Kalyanams' program, I made mistakes in everything else. I did not follow Your instructions. You warned me many times and guided me through spiritual experiences, yet I ignored them and erred, causing You pain. You took great effort to show me these experiences, and I troubled You despite that. You endured all that for the sake of this humble being."

Saying that due to my ignorance, I committed many mistakes, I confessed them one by one "You told me not to engage in business - I did not listen, You told me to give up the sense of 'mine' - I did not, You told me to remember You always without wasting time - I did not, You told me to develop the eligibility to attain you - I did not, I also made mistakes in the tasks You entrusted to me, as a result, I failed in the resolve I had made.

I prayed: "Forgive me, pardon me, protect me as Your servant. Grant me the path and the strength to fulfil my resolve." This prayer came from the depths of my heart. Tears flowed from my eyes. After some time, my heart became calm. Then again, I humbly prayed to the Lord - again and again - asking Him to bless and forgive me. I pleaded that He should forgive every mistake I had made over the past 20 years. I promised that from now on I would belong to Him and live as per His command. For a lowly servant like me, the Lord had taken so much trouble - and I was the cause of it. Crying out, I begged for forgiveness. Unable to control my sorrow, I wept in repentance for a long time. After that, I prayed again as follows...

I humbly prayed that He show me a way to repay His debt. I said that for the love and divine grace He

has shown, even if I were to serve for four lifetimes as I have in this one, I might only partially repay it. I begged Him to bless me for that. I also prayed that in every future birth, I should never forget the awareness that I am indebted to Him. I repeatedly requested that He remind me of this at every moment of every day. I said that all the service I have done in this lifetime is not even equal to the interest on His grace. Each one of His divine acts is so great that even an entire lifetime of service would not suffice to repay it - and He has granted me countless such blessings. Thinking of this, I broke down in tears, wondering how I could ever repay Him. I prayed that I would need many more births, and that in each birth, the opportunity to serve Him would depend solely on His grace. I offered this prayer in my office that evening. Within 12 hours, The Lord responded to my anguish in the following way:

Dream of 29-01-2022

In the dream, I was in our old house in my native village. A Haridas (a mendicant devoted to Hari) came seeking alms. Standing at the doorstep, he played his cymbals and chanted in his usual way, "Harilo Ranga Hari," asking for alms. I brought some rice in a small container and poured it into his akshayapatra (sacred alms vessel). In return, he took some rice from his vessel in his hand and poured it back into my container three times, as a blessing. While doing so, he said: "May you obtain the kind grace of Sri Venkateswara." The moment he uttered these words, they began to echo within my heart. At 5:30 a.m., the alarm rang and the dream ended - but the phrase continued to resonate within me again and again. Until about 8 a.m., I felt it echoing in my heart 30-40 times. In this way, Lord Venkateswara blessed me.

When I told my wife in the morning, she felt very happy. With this, the restlessness and longing I had felt over the past few days came to an end. Moreover, He



also indicated a way for my resolve to be fulfilled, as follows:

Instruction to Pray to Lord Anjaneya

Date 06-02-2022: On 05-02-2022 (Vasant Panchami), at 5:15 a.m., I received an inner spiritual experience. In this, the Lord instructed me to worship Lord Anjaneya (Hanuman). He told me to worship with deep devotion, with circumambulations, and with an intense, yearning heart. He directed me to pray to Lord Anjaneya to grant the strength and capability needed to fulfil my resolve. He specifically instructed me to pray to Lord Anjaneya in a temple where He is present along with Sri Mahankali. Such a temple exists in our own colony, on the way from my house to my office - Sri Mahankali Sameta Sri Ramalayam in Kakatiyanagar, Habsiguda, near my office. Every day, I pass in front of

this temple while going to and from work. The message was clear:

"Go there, worship Lord Anjaneya to your heart's content, pray for the fulfilment of your resolve, and receive His grace." Following the Lord's command, on 05-02-2022 at 11:30 a.m., I began worshipping Lord Anjaneya with 11 circumambulations. I continued this for 11 days, until Tuesday, 15-02-2022. After worshipping Lord Anjaneya, I also circumambulated Lord Sri Rama in the same temple, considering Him as Lord Venkateswara, and prayed for the strength and capability needed to fulfil my resolve.

Perhaps because, over the past few days, I had been humbly praying for the fortune of repaying the Lord's debt and for guidance and strength to fulfil my resolve, I felt that this instruction came as a response. I

also thought that, due to COVID halting the Kalyanam programs, the Lord might have instructed me to pray to Sri Anjaneya and Sri Rama so that the program could resume. After that, every day with great eagerness, I kept praying to the Lord to fulfil my resolve and grant me the necessary strength and capability. I considered myself insignificant, without any inherent ability, and prayed that only if He showed compassion could I succeed - otherwise I would not. I begged Him to grant me a service that would be remembered for generations because of me.

Meanwhile, with the help of a few known people, I began searching for a suitable place for the Lord's Hari Nama Kshetram. I strongly desired that this place be spacious, accessible to devotees, and that I should have complete authority over it. I looked in nearby areas like Habsiguda and Uppal. During this time, the Lord granted a divine experience. On 27-02-2022, while performing a prayer in the prayer room of our home, the Lord appeared in a special way - very beautiful, with strong and graceful arms, shining brilliantly with a unique radiance. It reminded me of a previous vision when He had appeared similarly, either while instructing me to establish continuous nama sankirtana (name recitation) or while indicating that He would attract devotees towards Himself. I felt very happy and took it as an auspicious sign.

Offering the merit of the "Sri Venkatesham" magazine to the Lord - and His acceptance

02-03-2022: We had started the "Sri Venkatesham" monthly magazine in April 2007. By 02-03-2022, all postings and payments to writers for the March 2022 issue were completed. With this, we completed 16 years of running the magazine and stepped into the 17th year. From April 2007 on through these 16 years, we ran the magazine according to the Lord's command. Now, with the intention of offering

the entire merit accumulated over these 16 years to the Lord, I prayed as follows - "O Lord! Just as the grain grown on land belongs entirely to the owner, so too the entire merit of these 16 years belongs only to You, O Sri Venkateswara! I am merely a servant. Therefore, as the owner, I offer all this merit to You." Taking water in my hands and chanting "Govinda, Govinda," I poured it at the Lord's feet. Thus, with deep devotion and surrender, I offered the entire merit of 16 years to my Lord, Tirumala Sri Venkateswara. After this, I felt a great sense of relief - my heart became light and peaceful. I prayed that He would continue to bless me, His servant, with more opportunities to serve Him in the future. I also humbly requested that He let me know within at least a week whether He had accepted this offering.

04-03-2022 was our wedding anniversary. We went to Tirupati a day earlier (03-03-2022) to receive the Lord's blessings. On 03-03-2022, we had two VIP darshans, and on 04-03-2022, we had two more. Even after having four darshans within 24 hours, I was not satisfied. I still wished to remain longer in the Lord's presence. However, my wife said that we should be content with whatever the Lord had granted. After that, we returned to Hyderabad with a heart filled with longing.

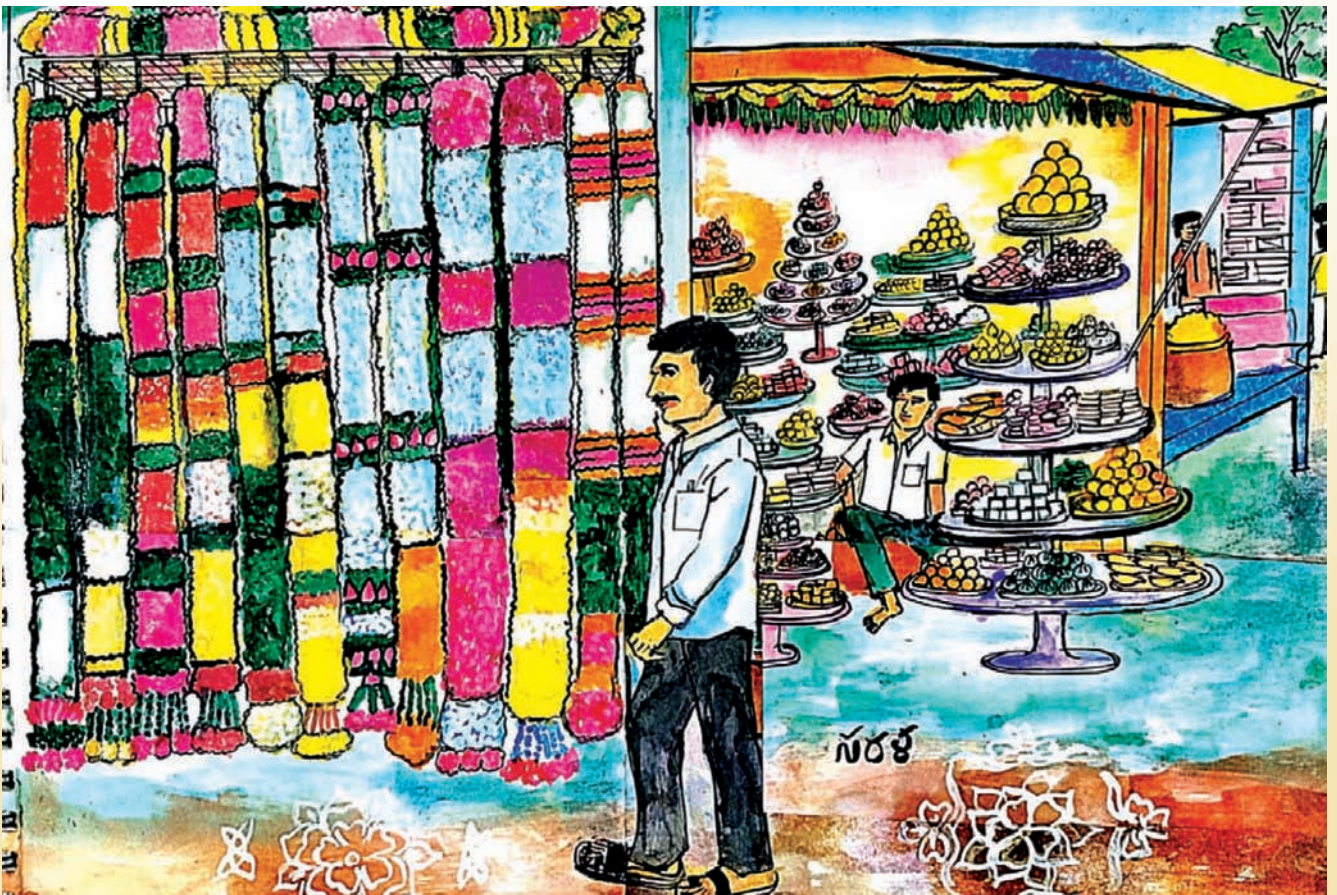
A few days ago, I had offered the entire merit accumulated from 16 years of publishing the Sri Venkatesham monthly magazine to my Lord. I had stated "O Lord, just as the ownership of the grain grown in a field belongs only to the landowner and not to those who work in the field," and had made this offering. On 02-03-2022 in Hyderabad, and again recently in Tirupati, I prayed that He accept this offering. I also hoped that He would show some divine sign. As I wished, this morning the Lord revealed a divine act indicating that He was very pleased with our magazine service.



Dream on 08-03-2022: In this dream, I went to a marketplace. Just like shops are decorated with flowers during Diwali, every shop there was magnificently decorated with flowers. As I walked around, I entered one particular shop. Inside, flower garlands had been made into long, thick festoons and were strung all over the shop. These garlands covered the walls and even the ceiling so completely that none of it was visible. At a height of about eight feet, thin wires were stretched like a mesh, and flower garlands were laid over them. From below, the view was extremely beautiful. From the top, garlands were hung down along every wall. Every inch of the shop - walls and ceiling - was covered entirely with these grand garlands. When I went inside, it looked astonishingly beautiful. I had seen decorations with flower garlands before, but never in my life had I seen such massive,

all-encompassing decoration using these large festoons covering everything so completely. The flowers were arranged in such a way that devotees could move freely without disturbance, and everything remained clearly visible. It was a very innovative and aesthetically pleasing arrangement. Amazed, I asked, "Why have you used so many tons of flowers? What is the occasion?" They replied something like, "Yesterday, Nagoba came to the sacred platform," implying that the Lord had visited the previous day, and hence this grand decoration was done.

Then I went to another shop. There, I saw tons of sweets and hundreds of varieties of offerings arranged as an offering to the divine. These too had been offered to the Lord during the previous day's festival. The sweets were stacked in plates one over another up to a height of about eight feet, as if arranged in layers. It



appeared that Marwari devotees had prepared 500-600 varieties of offerings and presented them in large vessels. All the offerings were arranged in a novel and orderly manner so that they were visible to the Lord.

After that, I stood on the road and joyfully looked at all the shops around me. At that moment, I felt as if I was speaking with my relative, Sri Nagireddy Sanjeeva Reddy. Then suddenly, I saw a young boy I knew. I was surprised - "Has he grown this much already?" He was from our family, once very small, but now he seemed to have grown to my height. Then the dream ended.

In this way, the entire marketplace was decorated with hundreds of tons of flower garlands and offerings, arranged on a grand and unique scale. I felt immense joy. I interpreted this as a sign that the Lord had accepted the merit of the 16 years of Sri Venkatesham.

Regarding Sri Sanjeeva Reddy garu - he is the father-in-law of my elder son Vedant. The boy I saw growing quickly to my height - I reflected on its meaning.

I have two sons. Sri Sanjeeva Reddy is related to my elder son. The boy seen beside him must be my elder son Vedant's son. Though he was a small child, he appeared to have grown quickly to my height. This suggests that by the time this section is published (May 2026), I may be blessed with a grandson, and that the Lord is accepting him as a devoted follower. I felt that he might play an important role in the future Hari Nama Kshetram. This is the third time the Lord has indicated that I would have a devoted grandson. In the dream, I felt surprised at how much he had grown in such a short time. This also suggests that during the time of publication, I may not be closely associated with my son or grandson, but instead may be living a more solitary life dedicated to the Lord's service.

Buying Shoes

Every divine act of the Lord carries both an immediate meaning and a deeper spiritual significance.

Even if it is not understood at the time of the dream, each act is shown with some purpose.

Dream on 17-03-2022: I went to a well-known branded shop, like Bata, probably to buy slippers or shoes. It was located in a busy marketplace. The area resembled the crowded lanes on both sides of the path leading to the Vishweshwara temple in Kashi. I walked through narrow alleys to reach the shop and asked for shoes. It was said to be a reputed company in India. The shop had two sections - one showroom and another used as a storeroom. I went into the storeroom and asked for shoes. The person there said something, but I was not satisfied and was about to leave for another shop. At that moment, in their showroom, I saw my engineering friend, Sri Basavaraj, managing the place. We greeted each other. He then brought me back into the storeroom and made me sit in a room. Though he was the head, managing this company in the region, he shared that he was undergoing many difficulties and expressed his troubles.

Since I was his friend, he introduced me to the person who had earlier shown me shoes and asked him to show me good ones. That person checked my foot size and brought me a pair of good walking shoes. They looked small, but when I wore them, they fit perfectly and were very comfortable. There was another pair nearby that looked slightly larger, which attracted my mind, but I did not try it. Then the dream ended.

Sri Basavaraj is my engineering friend, currently working as a Superintendent Engineer and head of the Irrigation Division in Siddipet. He got me well-fitting and comfortable shoes. However, even though my foot size is small, I felt that others might see me as childish or insignificant because of the small size. Still, I wore the shoes he gave and felt happy, thinking that I could walk anywhere comfortably with them.



Inner meaning of the dream: Even though the Lord grants me what is appropriate for me, my worldly attachments have not completely diminished. Internally, there is still a tendency to aspire for something greater or more impressive. Outwardly I may not express it, but this state would exist around the time of this publication (May 2026). I understood this meaning while doing the DTP work for this section.

The splendour of a kalyanam near our irrigation well

Dream on 18-03-2022: In this dream, it seemed that we had developed area around the irrigation well on our farm in Chinnagundavelli very well. Perhaps a temple had been built there along with a Kalyana mandapam. Along with some people, I was going from our house in the village towards the well area for a Kalyanam. Thinking that the Lord was present there and

we should receive Him ceremoniously, about 10 - 20 of us were going playing auspicious sounds. On the way, we reached up to Golla Yellaiah's well, which is before our land. Beyond that lies our field. At that moment, it appeared that some other Kalyanam-like event was already happening near our well. Many devotees were taking out a procession with great music and enthusiasm. These people were prominent - financially, socially, and politically well-established. Some of them stepped out of the procession and came toward us. They were coming from near our cattle shed towards the main road in front of our field. The main procession seemed to be happening in our land near the pond behind the cattle shed. Hearing the sounds, I told those with me: "See, many Kalyanams happen here. Someone must be conducting a Kalyanam."



Then the dream ended.

At that time, I did not understand its meaning but the true meaning was this: The Lord indicated that a temple should be built near our garden well, approximately near the lower side of the cattle shed. Behind it, Kalyana mandapams can be constructed. Overall, it suggests that the Lord intends to establish a permanent presence in the area near our irrigation well.

About 45 days earlier, one morning after finishing yoga, I had an inner feeling repeating "Shirshasana, Shirshasana" (headstand). From that day, I began practicing Shirshasana two to three times a week. I am doing it because the Lord indicated it, though I do not fully understand why. Perhaps it is a preparation - strengthening my mental state to face certain difficult situations in the future.

The Time for fulfilment of my desire was near

Over the past few days, I have been exploring many locations known to me to decide where the Hari

Nama Kshetram should be built, and I have been seeking the opinions of many people. I also prayed intensely to the Lord to show me a suitable place. This dream is the answer to that prayer.

Dream on 22-03-2022: In this dream, I was in our old house in our village Chinnagundavelli. I had the feeling that it was indeed our own home. Many relatives and close associates had gathered there for some prayer or yajna (sacrificial ritual). Everyone was engaged in different tasks related to the ritual. It seemed that this prayer or yajna had been going on for many days and had now reached its final stage. That is, I felt clearly that the time for the fulfilment of the purpose for which we had been performing this ritual had arrived. The entire program was being conducted under my mother's supervision. All the relatives and associates who had come were there at her invitation. My wife Surekha was also part of it, but her role was secondary. However, in the dream, neither my mother nor Surekha appeared physically - it was more of an inner awareness. I sensed



the bustle and noise of many people. Most importantly, there was a strong and clear feeling that the time for the fulfilment of my desire was very near. Then the dream ended.

The inner meaning was this: This indicates that the goal for which I have been performing the Lord's service like a yajna for the past 20 years is now close to being fulfilled. I felt very happy.
