Direction: Lord Tirumala Sri Venkateswara decided to arrange his “HARINAAMA KSHETRA” near our “Garden well” in my native village Chinna Gundavelli, 7 km. away from Sidhipet. He directed me to construct at least the replica of Tirumala Temple upto two compound walls (Silver Doors). He assured me that He will stay here permanently forever in this area by himself and bless the devotees. Also He suggested to arrange Akhanda Harinam Smaran (chanting constantly) by various devotees in shift system with no break. He also informed me to get blessed by Bhagavataas (great devotees) in order to get eligibility to invite Lord from Tirumala besides rigorous practice (Sadhana).

Starting the training from April 2000, thro’ my dreams, He disclosed the actual matter in April 2022. In addition to this, He ordered me to get the divine feelings published which were blessed by him in order to make the devotees

as partners in this programme from April 2023. The publishing of present part-36 is its part only **October 2022 to February 2023).**

Lord Sri Venkateswara of Tirumala redoubled my determination to fulfil His divine mission at any cost. At the same time, He began using my weaknesses to subject me to even more rigorous spiritual training. Along with entrusting me with new responsibilities, He also began removing additional defects within me that stood in the way of attaining spiritual eligibility (yogyata). The following incidents illustrate this.

Using the land dispute concerning our property at Dammaiguda, Hyderabad, He led me through many unexpected turns, placing me under tremendous mental strain. The owner of the adjoining land had encroached about 30 feet into my property. Since the mandal surveyor was taking a long time to conduct the official survey, we carried out a private digital survey with the neighbouring owner’s consent and installed boundary stones according to the survey. At that time, my son Vedant also came to the property. Without our knowledge, he took photographs of everything. Later, the neighbouring landowner used those photographs to allege that we had encroached upon his land, and filed a police complaint against me, my wife Surekha, and Vedant. Without conducting any proper inquiry, the police registered an FIR against us. As a result, I had to make repeated visits to the police station. It created a situation in which I appeared to be the wrongdoer. I was already

suffering from a heart-related ailment. Added to that, the police case caused me immense anguish. Every day I would travel to the disputed land and to the police station, returning home exhausted. Moreover, I felt that these constant interruptions were hindering the fulfilment of the Lord's mission, which caused me even greater distress. This pain and fear might not have been visible to others, but inwardly my heart was melting under the strain. It was a unique form of spiritual training - something that could only be experienced, not adequately described. As a result, my remembrance of the Lord increased many times over. I remembered Him without a moment's interruption. I could not imagine what the next day would bring. It was one of the most painful periods of my life. My mind gradually lost its composure. The Lord did not lessen this trial despite my repeated prayers. Instead, the suffering intensified day by day. It seemed that He was introducing an entirely new phase in my spiritual training. During this difficult and painful period, He simultaneously entrusted me with new responsibilities, thereby deepening my training.

Being Chosen as the Leader of the Devotees' Association

The Lord appointed me as the president of the devotees' association in our village, and through the following dream indicated that it would be my responsibility to help bring His grace to the devotees.

Dream of 19-10-2022: In the dream, I was elected president of the devotees' group in Chinnagundavelli village. Just as a village elects its Sarpanch (head of the village committee), the devotees of the village had chosen me as their representative. I was dressed in a traditional dhoti, wearing a ceremonial shawl and attire suitable for worship. At that moment, a thought arose within me: "I must look after the welfare of this village and ensure that all its devotees receive the blessings of the Lord. A responsibility has now been entrusted to me, and I must discharge my duty faithfully." Just as a Sarpanch is responsible for the welfare of the village, the Lord was instructing me that I should take responsibility for the welfare of the devotees' groups in the village. In other words, I

understood that I was to serve as an intermediary so that the devotees of that region might receive the grace of the Lord. The Lord chose to reveal this responsibility during one of the most difficult periods of my life, ensuring that I would remember it well. At that very time, I was facing serious illness on one side, a land dispute and repeated visits to the police station on the other. Amidst these hardships, I prayed to the Lord with the utmost intensity and humility.

I did not understand the purpose of the Lord's divine act, but I found myself trembling with fear.

Bestowing Worthiness Step by Step

Today I had a very unusual dream. It was extremely valuable because it revealed an inner transformation taking place within me without my being consciously aware of it. The dream ended when the alarm rang at 4:50 a.m. Lord Venkateswara of Tirumala has, without my knowing, been creating various divine acts (*lilas*), dangers, and fears in order to frighten me. Through these, He has been gradually directing my entire mind toward God and steadily elevating me over the past twenty-three years through spiritual practice. This small dream vividly illustrated that process.

Dream of 22-10-2022: A drama was being performed on a large stage before a great audience. I saw Lord Krishna standing on the stage, about six feet tall. In front of Him stood a young boy, about three feet in height. They faced one another. Krishna then took His flute and gently stroked the boy from the top of his head downward. Instantly the boy grew slightly taller. As he grew, he identified himself by the name of a particular devotee. Krishna continued stroking him with the flute from head to foot. With every stroke, the boy grew a little more and declared the name corresponding to that stage of spiritual growth. Eventually he said, **"I am Arjuna."** Krishna continued the process, and the boy kept growing until he became as tall as Krishna Himself. Finally, he declared, **"I am Krishna."**

The meaning was clear: through continuous spiritual discipline, one should ultimately attain the state that Lord Krishna desires. When the boy said, *"I am*



Krishna,” his face appeared exactly like Arjuna’s face from the television serial on Krishna - identical in height and radiance. Krishna Himself was visible only in profile (side view). Then the boy transformed into smoke and disappeared. The dream ended.

At the time I did not understand the dream. Its inner meaning, however, was this: For the past twenty-three years, every incident in my life has been gradually transforming me, bringing me step by step toward the spiritual state that the Lord desires for me. The dream also indicated that it is indeed possible to reach the level He expects. Furthermore, it suggested that the terrifying circumstances I am presently undergoing are themselves an integral part of that divine process.

Inviting problems onto myself

Three or four months earlier, I myself had prayed for these very difficulties. Day after day I would sit in my office with little work to do. With nothing to occupy

my mind, I became restless and bored. Therefore, I prayed to the Lord saying *“Please give me some hardships, so that I may have the blessed opportunity to remember and pray to You with intense longing.”*

Exactly as I had prayed, within the following two months one difficulty after another descended upon me:

- shortage of office staff,
- a land dispute with neighbouring property owners at the office,
- the land dispute at Dammaiguda,
- my heart ailment,
- the land dispute escalating into a police case,
- and finally, serious problems in my son’s family.

The troubles came one atop the another, leaving me hardly able to breathe under their weight. In the end I prayed saying *“Resolve all these problems. I*

surrender myself completely to You. Everything I possess I dedicate to You. Whatever remains after being used for the Hari Nama Kshetram alone will be for our own use."I repeatedly vowed that my mind would be devoted solely to His service. These problems made me tremble with fear. I felt trapped so completely that it was difficult even to breathe. I repeatedly circumambulated the temple of Sri Rama (who was accompanied by Sri Mahankali and Sri Hanuman), in our colony, praying fervently for deliverance. For twenty-two years I have witnessed the Lord's divine acts. I know I am His devotee and servant. I know with firm conviction that nothing whatsoever can happen without the grace and command of Lord Venkateswara, and that all these events are but His divine acts. Yet, despite this conviction, every new problem made me tremble. Never before in my life had I experienced such terrifying circumstances. Although I believed that each of these divine acts was intended to mature me spiritually, and that after a long period without experiencing such manifestations the Lord wished to rekindle within me the longing and eagerness to seek Him, the fear itself did not diminish.

Experiencing Divine Sweetness

On the evening of 26-10-2022, I prayed to the Lord in many different ways. I told Him that I was His servant and devotee and begged Him to resolve my health problems, land dispute, and my children's difficulties. Otherwise, I confessed, I was suffering intense mental anguish. Again and again, I sought refuge in Him, pleading that He save me in whatever way He chose. Finally, I made a vow saying if He protected me and restored joy to my life, I would dedicate yet another birth to His service. This meant that while I had already resolved to take fourteen human births to repay my debt by serving the Lord. With this vow, I added a fifteenth birth as well. On that day the Lord granted me the following divine experience.

Divine Experience of 27-10-2022: It was an inner spiritual impression rather than an ordinary dream. A feeling arose within me - "Throughout the entire day, the devotee is experiencing divine sweetness."

Immediately afterward, the alarm rang and the experience ended.

I understood its meaning to be this - By constantly remembering the Lord amid these difficult circumstances, I was meant to experience the sweetness (*madhurya*) of devotion. Through this, some degree of spiritual growth would take place within me, along with deeper dedication and greater love for the Lord.

For the past twenty-two years I have witnessed the Lord's divine acts. During complicated situations I had endured many hardships, but never before had I experienced suffering that caused such profound mental anguish. Unable to bear it, I requested devotees whom I knew to pray to the Lord on my behalf. I particularly sought the help of Sri Balaji, to whom the Lord would answer questions. He inquired about my condition, and later told me what the Lord had said - "It is enough if he remains calm and does not fear those problems." He also advised me to offer to the Lord the accumulated spiritual merit (*puGya*) of the twenty-eight Srinivasa Kalyanams that had been performed. He explained that if one keeps such merit for oneself, negative forces may become attracted to it and create adverse circumstances like these.

31-10-2022: That very day I came before the Lord and prayed: "Lord, I have erred. Please forgive me. I do not know whether I shall even live until tomorrow. Therefore, I offer at Your feet, right now, the merit of these twenty-eight Kalyanams. Please accept it." I ceremonially surrendered not only the merit of those Kalyanams but also the spiritual fruits of all the various services I had rendered. After doing so, I experienced myself as completely empty. And with that emptiness came peace.

Extending My Life

I had decided that, beginning in April 2023, the spiritual experiences granted by the Lord would be published serially in our monthly magazine, Sri Venkatesham. I also intended to make them available online through WhatsApp and our website. To prepare for writing them, I was rereading all of my experiences. At



the same time, however, I found myself trapped in a web of problems:

- my heart ailment,
- the land dispute,
- the police case,
- and the turmoil within Vedant's family.

These pressures overwhelmed me. It felt difficult even to breathe. Because of my heart condition, I began to doubt whether I would even live to see the next morning. Seeking relief, I surrendered to the Lord in every possible way. I promised to obey whatever He instructed and begged Him to forgive my mistakes. My wife and I resolved that the account of the Lord's divine acts that I was about to write would be completely truthful - like the testimony of a person lying on his deathbed, who speaks nothing but the truth. Yet despite all this, no relief came. My heart seemed to melt within me. I trembled with fear. At last, I asked the Lord for a single boon. I prayed saying "Please do not take me to You until I have fulfilled the mission You entrusted to me. Allow me first to establish the Hari Nama Kshetram and manage it for at least one year. Only after that may You call me to Your abode."

I further prayed: "Grant that, in this very lifetime, I may behold You to my heart's content, perform worship at Your holy feet, and speak with You personally. Only after that should death come to me." In response to this prayer, the Lord granted me a remarkable dream.

On 02-11-2022, beginning around 4:00 a.m., He revealed a single dream in two parts. The first part ended when the alarm rang. After going back to sleep, the very same dream resumed, continuing with its second part. I finally awoke at 5:00 a.m. By then, the dream had continued uninterrupted until I awoke.

Dream of 02-11-2022 – First Part: The setting was our old ancestral house in our village, where I was living. Sri Sri Sri Chinna Jeeyar Swamiji arrived at our house accompanied by his personal attendant. Swamiji sat silently on a mat placed beside the wooden platform near the inner courtyard. His face appeared sorrowful,

and He remained completely silent. Meanwhile, His attendant was searching for me. When I saw him, I recognized him as someone well known to me. I first offered my respects to Jeeyar Swamiji. Since we could not speak freely before Swamiji, the attendant and I stepped outside to talk. I asked him, "What is the matter? Why has Swamiji come all the way to my house with such effort?" Before replying, the attendant hesitated. Then he asked me to give him my Facebook account (or something similar). In other words, they had come to take over my account. He explained that it was an excellent account, fully in accordance with the Sri Vaishnava tradition, completely free from commercial motives, and entirely devoted to the philosophy of the Bhagavatas. Therefore, they wanted it. I thought carefully and, though with a heavy heart, replied, "I'm sorry, I cannot give it to you."

I explained that I was about to publish the divine acts of the Lord through it, that it had become extremely important to me, and that it was indispensable for fulfilling the mission entrusted to me by the Lord. For a long time, he insisted that they needed it, while I firmly refused. Finally, the attendant went back and informed Jeeyar Swamiji. Swamiji, however, remained seated exactly where He was, without moving. It seemed that He was determined to obtain the account somehow. Just then the alarm rang, and the dream ended.

Dream – Second Part: I lay down again, and the same dream resumed. This time, however, Jeeyar Swamiji was no longer sitting where He had been before. Instead, He had moved near the main entrance, sitting in the darkness before a small room where cow-dung cakes were stored. As I came from the kitchen and noticed Him sitting there in the dark, I switched on the light. The moment the light came on, Swamiji immediately moved inside that small room and sat there. It seemed as though He did not wish to sit in the light. So, I turned the light off. Immediately He came back outside. The two of them discussed something privately. At last, I asked the attendant, "Why are you taking my Facebook account? Have you taken anyone else's in the same way?" He replied, "Oh yes, we have taken many people's



accounts.”Then Jeeyar Swamiji emerged from the room. So that no one would recognize Him, He had changed into ordinary clothes - a pair of trousers and a T-shirt - and appeared ready to leave.

The dream ended.

Thus, Swamiji remained in my house for several hours in the dream, yet He never spoke a single word to me. It seemed as though He intended to depart unnoticed, dressed like an ordinary person. Since Jeeyar Swamiji would not remain where light fell upon Him, I later interpreted this to mean that He had come in a subtle, spiritual form to take me to the other world. At the time of the dream, however, I did not understand its true meaning. Therefore, on the very next day, the Lord granted me another dream conveying almost the same message, enabling me to understand it correctly. Together, these two dreams transformed my life completely. There is no doubt that they compelled me, with unwavering determination, to fulfil the Lord’s mission.

I felt that my former life had ended. From that point onward, the Lord had granted me an entirely new life—an extended life. I resolved that this extended life must be used only for fulfilling the Lord’s divine mission and for nothing else. The dream instilled in me a firm determination to remain constantly vigilant, never becoming careless, until I achieved success.

This dream ended when the alarm rang at 4:50 a.m.

Dream of 03-11-2022: I was travelling in a train. Every compartment was packed with passengers. Whenever each passenger’s destination arrived, they got off at their respective station - or rather, it seemed as though some unseen divine force pushed them out of the train. At one station, I too was pushed out. After getting down, I looked around and realized that this was **not** my destination. I had no desire to get off there. But I could not re-enter the train either, because it was so crowded that there was not even enough space



to place a single foot inside. Not knowing what else to do, I clung to one of the window bars on the outside of the moving train and continued travelling while hanging from it. Meanwhile, another railway carriage approached from the opposite direction on the same tracks. It was extraordinarily black and as tall as a palmyra tree. The owner of that train was travelling in it. When it appeared, the train on which I was travelling came to a halt. The driver of my train and the owner of the other train spoke with one another. Then someone ordered that I be allowed back inside. Space was made for me. I was brought into the compartment, given a seat, and the train resumed its journey.

At that moment the alarm rang, and the dream ended.

Meaning: In a single sentence, I understood the dream to mean this: My previous life had effectively come to an end. Because I had prayed that my life should end only after I had fulfilled the Lord's mission and attained Him, the Lord had granted me an extension of life. I

therefore resolved that this extended life should be devoted exclusively to fulfilling the Lord's purpose - not to anything else. It should never be wasted or used for worldly pursuits. With that conviction, I offered countless prostrations and my deepest gratitude to my Lord, Tirumala Sri Venkateswara.

Introspection – Prayer

Date: 04-11-2022

The Lord extended my life. I resolved that I would use this extended life only to fulfil His divine mission and for no other purpose - not for worldly happiness or for any personal pursuits. I took a solemn vow that I would live with utmost devotion and sincerity, constantly meditating upon Him, with my attention fixed solely on accomplishing His will. However, I also realized that I was as powerless as a tuft of cotton and that I live amidst the distractions of the Kali Yuga. Therefore, I prayed to my Lord, Sri Venkateswara of Tirumala, to grant me the necessary strength, to inspire me continuously, and to enable me to accomplish this task.



Granting Courage

Date: 05-11-2022

Recently, the mandal surveyor surveyed our land but, for certain reasons, postponed the final survey and issued a notice stating that it would be conducted again on 09-11-2022. Meanwhile, the dispute took a new turn. The owner of the neighbouring land, who opposed me, filed a writ petition in the High Court seeking to stop the survey. He made the police, the District Collector, the Tahsildar, and us parties to the case. The hearing was scheduled for 08-11-2022. This frightened me even more. I worried whether the survey would ever take place and feared that the dispute would become even more complicated. The previous evening, at about 6:45 p.m., while at my office, I prayed earnestly to the Lord. Fear had completely drained my courage. I pleaded with Him, asking that if nothing else, He would at least grant me courage. As I reached the end of my prayer, I experienced something remarkable. It felt as though a divine energy emerged from the Lord's photograph before me and entered my heart. Instantly, courage arose within me. The fear that had gripped me disappeared. I felt that the Lord was conveying a simple message: "Be courageous." That night I told my wife about this experience. I encouraged her to remain courageous as well. I said "At the worst, we may lose a portion of the land. We should not grieve over it. Whatever is destined for us alone will come to us. Let us abandon anxiety and live peacefully." Overall, I understood that problems will continue to arise in life, but one must face them with courage, trusting that Sri Venkateswara Himself takes care of everything.

Just as a piece of iron must be heated repeatedly and struck with a hammer before it can be shaped into the desired form, so too the Lord continues to subject me to various hardships until I attain the state He desires for me. He assures me that He is with me throughout these trials, although the circumstances themselves do not inspire confidence. I realized that what the Lord seeks is for me to develop the strength to stand firm despite adverse circumstances.

The courage He granted me lasted only for a single day. By the next morning, He withdrew it. Once again, I found myself trembling with attachment and fear. It seemed that His intention was for me to attain fearlessness through my own spiritual practice, rather than by depending on temporary divine consolation.

Accepting My Unworthiness and Renouncing the Desire to Attain the Lord

Date: 07-11-2022

For several days I had been struggling with one crisis after another: the land dispute, the police case, court proceedings, my health problems, and my son's family issues. Together they weighed upon me so heavily that I could scarcely breathe. Unable to bear it, I repeatedly prayed to the Lord. On one occasion He reassured me through the symbolic act of offering me a laddu in a dream. On another, He advised me to remain courageous. Yet the problems continued to grow day by day. Meanwhile, my health worsened because of constant fear. Earlier, my doctor had advised me to undergo an immediate examination of my heart. However, because of certain spiritual experiences that I believed were guided by the Lord, I had told my wife that we should wait about twenty-five days before going to the hospital. But recently my chest pain had increased, and breathing became difficult. Whenever I suggested going to the hospital immediately, my wife reminded me of my own earlier decision to wait. As a result, I began to wonder whether I would even live to see the next day. Every morning, upon waking, I offered thanks to the Lord for having extended my life by yet another day. Finally, after reflecting deeply on my condition, I prayed thus "I do not possess true devotion or unwavering faith in Sri Venkateswara. A genuine devotee does not tremble before difficulties. Therefore, I conclude that I lack the necessary spiritual qualification. I am unworthy. Since I do not deserve to attain You, I relinquish my desire to attain You. Please forgive me." At the same time, I made another solemn vow "Even though I renounce the desire to attain You personally, I will nevertheless fulfil the mission You have entrusted to me." In truth, my original resolve had always been to



serve selflessly throughout my life—without expecting anything in return and until I myself was fully satisfied. Attaining the Lord, I felt, was only an added blessing, a bonus—not my primary objective. Thus, I concluded that no service should ever be performed with the expectation of attaining God as a reward. One should perform one's duty simply because it is one's duty.

And I accepted, with honesty and humility, what I believed to be my own unworthiness.

Extending My Life by Implanting Two Stents

Realizing that my health was steadily deteriorating, we finally went to the hospital on 12 November 2022. In accordance with the dreams the Lord had shown me, the doctors performed an angiogram and implanted two stents. Thus, my life was extended. My wife, who watched the procedure on the monitor in the operating theatre, was terrified. The doctor later told her that it had been difficult for me even to survive until the operation, and that my survival itself was possible only through the grace of Sri Venkateswara. Having lived through such a critical condition and received this extension of life granted by the Lord, I now continue to live. I solemnly resolved, at the Lord's lotus feet, that I would use this extended life only to fulfil His divine mission. I offered countless prostrations to Him.

Guidelines for My Future Life

Date: 24-11-2022

From this day onward, I laid down the following principles for the rest of my life. I must always live with the conviction that all the property I possess belongs entirely to Sri Venkateswara. Therefore, if any property is lost in disputes, I should regard it as belonging to Him rather than to me and should not grieve, thinking that nothing of mine has truly been lost. The Lord caused me to be born in Chinnagundavelli and sustains me in Hyderabad solely so that I may fulfil His divine mission. My only duty should be to accomplish that mission. Therefore, if disputes regarding property or other worldly matters arise, I should not allow my attention to become absorbed in them. Only by living in this manner, I felt, could I truly reform myself, become spiritually qualified,

and develop a firm and steady mind. I practiced this attitude for several days. However, whenever the land dispute resurfaced, I found myself unable to maintain self-control. My efforts at spiritual practice failed. I lamented within myself for being unable to overcome worldly attachment and sought the Lord's forgiveness. Although the case was pending before the High Court, the Mandal Surveyor conducted the survey on 09 November 2022 and concluded that my neighbour had encroached upon 35 feet of my land. However, since the opposing party had not been present during the survey, the High Court cancelled the survey and ordered that both properties be surveyed again in the presence of all concerned. Thus, the dispute remained unresolved. Since I had no idea when another survey would take place, I considered selling the entire property at whatever price I could obtain simply to free myself from the problem. I asked the Lord for His permission, but He gave none. My attempt to sell the land also failed. Therefore, I concluded that the Lord intended me to use this problem itself as a means of further spiritual practice. Thus, He placed me in circumstances where I had to do abhyasa (constant practice) and practice vairagya (detachment).

At the same time, my wife Surekha was undergoing a similar test. She dearly loves children. Although she was qualified for employment, she chose not to work so that she could devote herself entirely to raising our children. She instilled good values and conduct in them. However, during this period, our elder son, Vedant, began creating disturbances over trivial matters. He would shout at everyone in the house like a person who had lost mental balance. The situation became so severe that when he went to America for six months, he drove his in-laws out of his house within just forty-five days. He frequently quarrelled with his wife and her parents and frightened them. His roaring outbursts were so terrifying that everyone who witnessed them became afraid. My wife suffered greatly because of this and constantly tried to reconcile both sides. Eventually, my son and daughter-in-law reached a point where they felt they could no longer live together. Finally, they reached a compromise under which members of one side would

no longer communicate with those of the other. From that time onward, our daughter-in-law and her relatives stopped speaking to us properly and no longer invited us to family functions. At first, I believed that the Lord was using my son as an instrument for my spiritual training. Later, however, I came to understand that these events were also the working out of our own karmic consequences.

On one occasion, when Vedant's parents-in-law visited our younger son's house in the same American city, they reportedly told our younger daughter-in-law "If you don't have enough money, you should ask your father-in-law to buy you a better house." Their remark suggested that our financial resources should be used for their personal comforts. From that day onward, Vedant developed intense resentment toward them. He began harassing them and repeatedly demanded that they leave his house immediately. Even after they apologized, he did not calm down. Although we repeatedly advised him, he would become calm for a moment and then immediately lose his temper again. In reality, although he himself tried to regain control, he lacked the strength to overcome the hatred that had taken hold of his mind. His anger would surge like the hissing of a cobra. At such moments he lost all sense of discrimination regarding what was right or wrong. He mocked, mimicked, ridiculed, and abused them. Anyone who witnessed his behaviour was bound to become frightened.

Preparations for Publishing My Spiritual Experiences – Remembering Bhadra

On 14 December 2022, after attending the Suprabhata Seva at Tirumala, we had a deeply fulfilling darshan of the Lord. I prayed that He would bless and inspire me to begin publishing the spiritual experiences He had bestowed upon me. Then, on 16 December 2022, we went to Bhadrachalam and performed the Lord's Kalyanam there. Once again, I prayed for the strength to accomplish His mission and for inspiration to publish my experiences. Immediately, Bhadra, the devotee after whom Bhadrachalam is named, came to my mind. A firm conviction arose within me that, just as Bhadra became the instrument through whom the Lord manifested

Himself at Bhadrachalam, Sri Venkateswara would establish the Hari Nama Kshetram at Chinnagundavelli through me. Finally, by 30 December 2022, I had completed reading all of the spiritual experiences I had received. The next step was to write them down. I planned to publish each instalment in the *Sri Venkatesham* monthly magazine, with each part covering about eight or nine pages. Since I wanted the first two instalments to explain the Lord's complete divine purpose, I intended them to total about twenty-four pages. The first part would present the Lord's overall objective, while the second would provide a concise account of the principal divine experiences I had received from the year 2000 through March 2023. However, the Lord had granted me many thousands of spiritual experiences. Trying to compress them into twenty-four pages was as difficult as trying to confine the waters of an entire lake within a single well. Therefore, I began systematically selecting and arranging only the most important experiences in an orderly manner.

The Lord's Blessing – Assuring Us That He Would Come to Our Home

We left for Tirumala on 8 January 2023 to have darshan through the Vaikuntha Dwaram (Vaikuntha Entrance). More importantly, I was about to begin publication of a series under the title "The divine guidance of Lord Venkateswara of Tirumala," and we were travelling by the Narayanadri Express to seek the Lord's blessings for this undertaking. That night I had the following experience.

Divine Experience – 09-01-2023: This was an inner spiritual feeling rather than a dream. I experienced the impression "You are coming to receive My blessings. I am pleased." After having darshan of the Divine Mother at Tirupati, we climbed the hill and had Vaikuntha Dwara Darshan twice. On both occasions I prayed earnestly to the Lord "This is one of the most important undertakings of my life. Please bless me and grant me Your inspiration and strength." While inside the Vaikuntha entrance, I also carefully observed and noted the structures within it - their dimensions and



architectural features. That night, while we were still on the hill, my wife Surekha also had a dream in which the Lord indicated that He would come to our home.

Dream of 10-01-2023: In the dream we were at home. As Surekha walked past the kitchen, she glanced into our prayer room. Above the idols in our shrine, a photograph of Sri Venkateswara normally hangs on the wall. But in the dream, the photograph was gone. In its place a small opening had emerged from the wall, rather like a chick breaking through an eggshell. After finishing her work, she passed by the shrine again. This time she saw the head of a snake emerging through the opening. The snake was an intense jet black, completely without markings. Later she returned once more, and by then the snake had emerged up to about a span in length and was moving about. Surprisingly, she felt no fear on seeing it, only amazement. After attending to another task in the bedroom, she returned again. This time the snake had emerged much farther and was lying upon the floor, looking directly at her. It was entirely jet black, with not a single mark on its body. Even then she experienced no fear—only wonder. She called out to tell us that a snake had appeared, but we paid no attention and continued our conversation as though nothing unusual had happened.

The dream ended there.

The snake had emerged precisely from the place in our prayer room where the photograph of Sri Venkateswara was normally placed, and it rested upon the platform of the shrine itself. This dream occurred at Tirumala on 10 January 2023. Previously, on several occasions, the Lord had already told Surekha that He would appear to her in the form of a snake. Therefore, we understood this dream as the Lord's assurance that He Himself would one day come to our home. What greater blessing could we possibly desire?

“Write in a Way That Leaves Readers Astonished”

Divine Experience of 28-01-2023: On this day, as I was waking up, an inner inspiration—not a dream—arose within me regarding the series I was about

to publish, “The divine direction of Lord Venkateswara of Tirumala.” The impression was that it should be written with great depth and grandeur, in a manner that would leave readers astonished. I too desired to write these experiences in such a compelling way that devotees would eagerly continue reading them. I wanted the work to appeal alike to scholars, ordinary readers, and thoughtful analysts.

Beginning to Write My Spiritual Experiences

01-02-2023: During January I had arranged the important events in chronological order. Then, on Wednesday, 1 February 2023 (Bhishma Ekadashi), I formally began writing my spiritual experiences. For the previous two days I had been praying to the Lord about how I should begin. At 5:45 a.m., while practising pranayama, I received the following inner inspiration” Begin by saying: ‘Lord Venkateswara of Tirumala is my Master; I am His servant. He alone is the doer, the action, and the instrument. I am merely a tool in His hands.’” Following this inspiration, I prayed to the Lord and began writing.

Do Not Seek Any Other Form or Place

On 15 February 2023, my wife and I visited Sri Rama Nama Kshetram in Guntur to observe their continuous chanting of the divine name of Lord Rama. We wanted to understand how uninterrupted chanting had been maintained there for nearly eighty to ninety years, thinking that it might serve as a model for our proposed Hari Nama Kshetram. The following day, 16 February 2023, we visited Dwaraka Tirumala, where we had prolonged darshan of the Lord until our hearts were satisfied, praying for the successful fulfilment of our mission. We returned to Hyderabad that evening. Yet, despite visiting both places, neither of us experienced complete inner satisfaction. The Lord then conveyed the following message through a dream.

Dream of 17-02-2023: The dream conveyed that I should not seek refuge in any other form of the Divine or in any other sacred place, but should follow only Lord Venkateswara of Tirumala and His temple. In the dream, I climbed an ancient stone fort and carefully explored



its ruined portions, praying that the Lord would reveal wonderful divine manifestations that would fill me with spiritual ecstasy. I examined everything with great concentration. Yet I witnessed no miracle. Disappointed, I turned back and left.

That was the entire dream.

By this time, I had prepared rough drafts of the first and second parts of my spiritual experiences. In the first part, to the best of my understanding, I explained the Lord's overall purpose. Following the Lord's earlier guidance, I began with the opening two sentences He had inspired and then summarized the hidden meaning behind His divine play from the year 2000 through March 2023—the steps I had taken, the mistakes I had made, and the ways in which the Lord corrected me. In particular, I wrote that just as the Lord had once used Bhadra to establish Bhadrachalam, and Sage Yadagiri to establish Yadagirigutta, He now intended to use me to establish the Hari Nama Kshetram at Chinnagundavelli. However, I had written this as my own inference; the Lord had never explicitly told me so. Therefore, I prayed saying “O Lord Venkateswara!

You always make the words of Your devotees come true. Long ago, to vindicate Prahlada's words, You manifested Yourself from a pillar of stone. Likewise, I have told Your devotees that, just as You established Bhadrachalam and Yadagirigutta through Your chosen instruments, You will establish, through me, a sacred shrine as spiritually powerful as a Divya Desam (a sacred place where Sri Maha Vishnu and Sri Maha Laxmi are said to have established themselves). Therefore, I pray that You do not let my words prove false.”

I also described the special period of training that I underwent between 9 October 2022 and 10 December 2022, and included, as an example of the Lord's grace, the blessing He had bestowed upon me through the opportunity of serving His feet. In the second part, I presented a concise account of the principal spiritual experiences the Lord had granted me. This, too, I completed as a rough draft. Then the Lord indicated that I had forgotten to include one important point in the second part. Through a further inspiration, He suggested that it should be presented in such a way that it would remain like a puzzle for the devotees who read it.



Making It Like a Puzzle for the Devotees Who Read It

Dream of 18-02-2023: In this dream, I was lying on the bed in the bedroom of our house. Our driver, Kaleem, came in and, with great affection and familiarity, lay down beside me on the same bed, crossing one leg over the other. He then took my hand into his own, placed it upon his leg, and gently pressed it with warmth and affection.

That was the entire dream.

The meaning of this dream can be understood only by paying close attention to the Lord's divine play and relating it to the work I was then engaged in. Otherwise, it would make little sense. Kaleem had been working as our driver since 2003. He was also the driver of the "Namo Venkatesaya" Ratha (chariot) during our Ratha Yatra. While preparing my spiritual experiences for publication, I had forgotten to include one important teaching that the Lord had given during the Ratha Yatra—that all those who serve the Lord should be regarded equally. The Lord showed me this dream in order to remind me of that forgotten point.

I also made this appeal to every devotee who would read these spiritual experiences "I am recording these experiences exactly as they occurred. Without being influenced by my own interpretations, I request you to analyse the Lord's divine play independently and discover its true meaning for yourselves. Consider these experiences as a kind of puzzle placed before you." I also prayed to the Lord to bless every devotee who reads these experiences.

With this, the rough drafts of the **first** and **second** parts of my spiritual experiences were completed. As I wrote them, I found myself even more deeply affected than when I had originally undergone the experiences themselves. There is no doubt in my mind that each section has the power to bring about profound inner transformation within me.

My Spiritual state

- I was instructed to prepare myself so that the Lord's grace could flow to groups of devotees through me.
- My life had been extended for the purpose of establishing the Hari Nama Kshetram.
- Every hardship was becoming another step leading me closer to the Lord.
- My spiritual discipline had become much more rigorous.
- I had now begun writing my spiritual experiences for publication.

Kalyanams Performed During This Period

From the 28th Kalyanam through the 37th Kalyanam, a total of ten Kalyanams were performed.
